

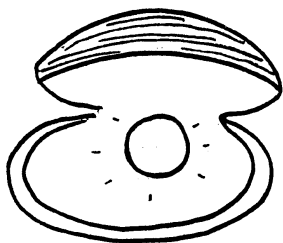
Mystery in the Depths
