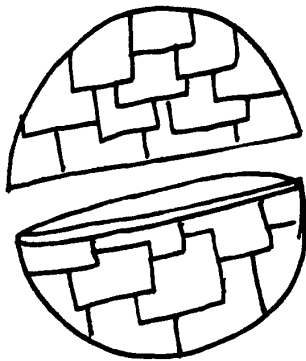
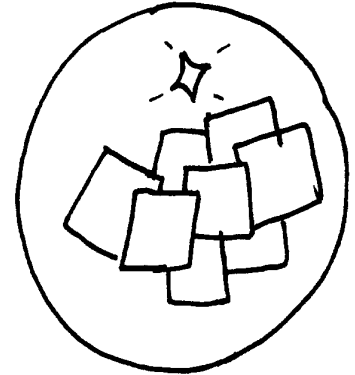


Make your own Fund Box

You will need:

- ☺ a large orange.
- ☺ newspaper, cut into small neat squares.
- ☺ wallpaper paste, made into a thick mixture.
- ☺ 5 tops from toothpaste tubes,
- ☺ a sharp cutting tool (ask an adult),
- ☺ glue
- ☺ bright paint,
- ☺ varnish.



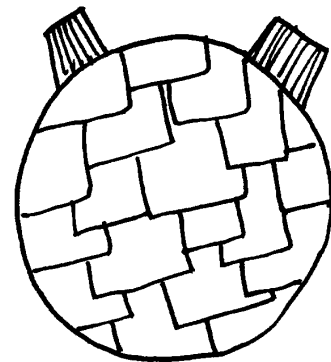
- 1) Wet some squares of paper and place them neatly over the orange.
- 2) Paint over them with a coating of paste.
- 3) Stick more squares on top - completely cover the orange 4 or 5 times over.
- 4) Put the orange in a warm place to dry out
- 5) Carefully cut in half (ask for help).
- 6) Remove the orange and glue the halves back together.

7) Glue the

toothpaste tops in place for legs.

Stick one in place for the nose.

- 8) Cover the whole thing with 2 more layers of paper, finishing with a white layer.
- 9) When its properly dry, cut a slot in the top for coins, and a hole in the bottom for taking money out.
- 10) Paint and varnish your Fund Pig.
- 11) Block the hole in the bottom with a wad of tissue or cotton wool or a cork.



**When you have some money in your pig take it along to the Feast.
Give a short talk at the Feast telling how you made it and how you've
saved up the money.
The adults will feel so inspired they will want to give more to the Fund.**
