

Giving to the Fund

The Fund is very important.

Without money it would be difficult to teach.

We need it to buy books, to advertise, to hold meetings and to organise children's activities.

Everybody's contribution, however small, is needed if we are to tell people about Bahá'u'lláh.

Some ideas for you:



- ☺ Organise a sale for the social part of the Feast.
- ☺ Make up your mind to make a sacrifice. Think of something you buy that is a treat for you, e.g. chocolate, a canned drink or a hired video, and occasionally go without it and put your money in the Fund Box instead.
- ☺ Have an 'odd job week'. Ask your parents, and other Bahá'ís, if you can do jobs for the Fund. You could wash the car on the outside, clean it on the inside; go to the shop; cut the grass; tidy the shed; wash up; do some baking; clean the windows etc.
- ☺ Ask the Treasurer of your Assembly to tell the children about the different funds.
- ☺ Make your own Fund Box
