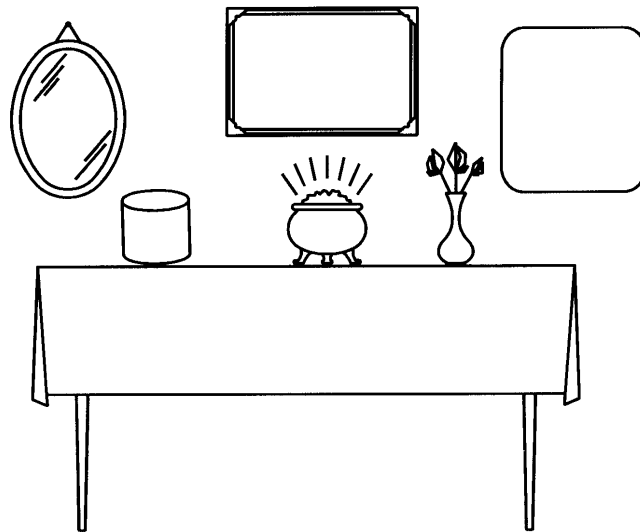


# Make a Prayer Corner for the Báb

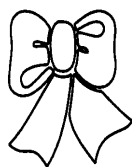
**This would be a wonderful way to remember The Báb**

- 1) Find a quiet place in your home. It could be:
  - ★ a corner of your bedroom
  - ★ in the sitting room
  - ★ a spare room
  - ★ a space in the hall or on the landing.
- 2) Make sure it is clean and tidy.  
{The Báb said cleanliness is very, very important.}
- 3) Find a small table, desk or even a stool to put things on.



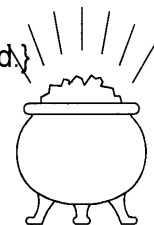
- 4) Cover it with a clean cloth.

**Try to gather some of these things together and put them on the table:**



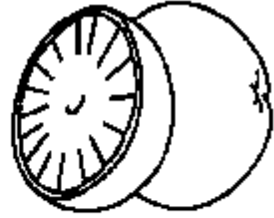
★ Something green, like this ribbon. {The Báb always wore a green turban and sash because He was descended from Muhammad.}

★ A small bowl containing something with a nice smell.  
{Some sandalwood would be ideal, because it would remind us that The Báb is buried in a coffin of sandalwood.}

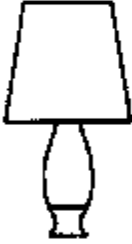




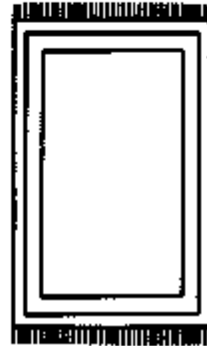
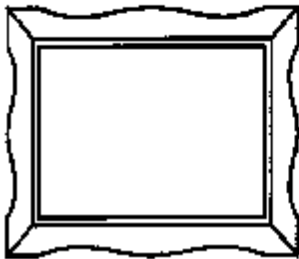
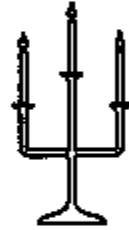
\* An orange. (The Báb planted an orange tree in the courtyard of His house in Shiraz.)



\* Pick some flowers and put them in a pretty vase.



\* You may be allowed to put a candle or lamp on the table.

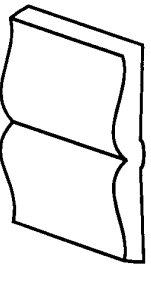
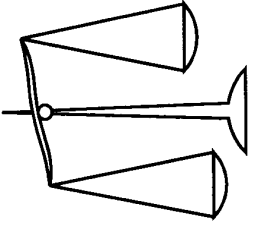
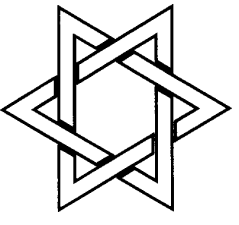
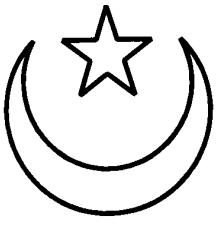
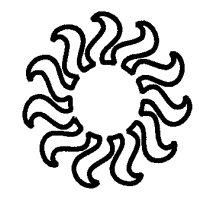


On the wall you could hang:

- \* A mirror (to remind you that the Báb was like a pure mirror reflecting the light of God).
- \* A picture of the Shrine of the Báb.
- \* A prayer of the Báb written neatly and decorated.

**The main message of the Báb was that we should recognise Bahá'u'lláh and follow His Teachings.**
