31 May 1872	Thomas Breakwell born
June 1901	Met Mae Bolles
“The air was warm and heavy, not a leaf was stirring, when suddenly a wind struck me and whirled around me, and in that wind a voice said...’Christ has come again! Christ has come again!”	Thomas’s feeling after his first meeting with May.
Told about Bahá’u’lláh and martyrs	Second meeting with May
My Lord, I believe, forgive me, Thy servant Thomas Breakwell	Thomas’s letter to Abdu’l-Bahá asking permission to make a pilgrimage.
July 1901	Pilgrimage to ‘Akká
“You may leave Paris at any time”	Abdu’l-Bahá’s cablegram to Mae
Remain in Paris to Teach the Faith	Abdu’l-Bahá’s instruction to Thomas
Every fortnight	Thomas wrote to Abdu’l-Bahá while in Paris
13 June 1902	Died in Paris at the age of 30
1903	Thomas Breakwell’s father writes to Abdu’l-Bahá
