Kyoko is a twelve-year-old Japanese girl who finds that her life is suddenly about to change. Her parents have been invited by the Universal House of Justice to go to the Bahá'í World Centre in Haifa to serve the Faith. And Kyoko will be going with them.

This book tells the story of how Kyoko deals with leaving her best friend behind in Japan, and about her life in a new country, at a new school, and with new friends. It also describes what it feels like to be living close to the Shrines of the Báb and Bahá'u'lláh every day and being among children from many different parts of the world.

When you read this book, you will feel that you are with Kyoko as she sets out on her adventure.
